## **Course Objectives**

By the end of the course, you will be able to:

- Compare a variety of lessons and resources included in Integrating Career Awareness into the ABE &
  ESOL Classroom (ICA) Curriculum Guide to assist students completing a Career and Education
  Planning Worksheet.
- Complete a Lesson Planning Template from the *ICA Curriculum Guide* that is tailored to the student levels, intensity of instruction, length of your program cycle and aligned, where applicable, to your state or program content standards.
- Determine the preparation, classroom time, and resources that you will need in order to deliver the lessons that you've included in your Lesson Planning Template.
- Apply a framework for setting a personal goal and discuss how you would introduce this framework to students to help them set concrete goals.
- Navigate, compare, and assess local and online resources to complement the *ICA* lessons, such as career exploration websites, college websites, One Stop Career Centers, and potential guest speakers.
- List the education steps needed towards a credential in a specific career pathway and identify a postsecondary institution in your area that provides such training.
