Experience working with nonnative speakers of English, immigrant and refugee populations, and diverse cultures. Excellent oral and written communication skills, and strong computer skills. Some travel in employee's car is required; must have a valid Massachusetts driver's license. Ability to successfully perform the essential functions of this job. Reasonable accommodations, where possible, may be made to enable individuals with disabilities to perform the essential tasks.
