## **Authentic News Checklist**

The authentic news article contains:

A catchy title or headline that addresses the topic of the article
 An opening statement that grabs the reader's attention
 Major details of the subject in the first paragraph (who, what, where, when, why, and how if relevant)
 Facts that have been obtained from reliable sources (does not contain opinion or any of the author's personal commentary) and mentions the source of information
 At least two paragraphs

## Satirical Article Checklist

The satirical article:

Has a title that lets the reader know the article is satirical and poking fun a
an issue
Makes it clear what issue, person, or event is being satirized
Contains exaggerated or fictional supporting reasons such as fake quotes and statistics
Maintains a light, humorous tone
Is at least two paragraphs in length

## **Grammar and Mechanics For Both:**

Each sentence has proper punctuation at the end (period, exclamation point,
question mark)
Sentences begin with a capital letter
Commas are used when needed
Sentences are complete and not fragments
Transitions are used between paragraphs and ideas and sentences flow smoothly
Words are spelled correctly
