Adult ESOL Teacher (Full-time and part-time positions available)

Schedule:

- 8:30am-12:30pm Monday - Friday (ESOL Class)
- 6-9pm, Mondays, Tuesdays, and Wednesdays (DESE Evening ESOL Class)
- Position runs from September - December 2018 with potential to continue.

\$20-23/hour + prep at same hourly rate

Description of Position:

- Teach ESOL to adults of diverse linguistic, cultural, religious, socio-economic and educational backgrounds
- Survey and incorporate adult learner goals into coursework for a student-centered, goal-oriented participatory ESOL class
- Review and track goals and achievements with students, and maintain student portfolios documenting progress
- Collaborate with Career Advisor to ensure that all students are progressing. Identify students who need extra support meeting their educational and career goals
- Outline teacher and program expectations to the students clearly at the beginning of each new unit
- Prepare and deliver engaging, learner-centered lessons
- Integrate reading, writing, pronunciation, grammar, speaking and listening skills
- Follow scope and sequence curriculum.
- Communicate classroom/student issues to Program Director in a timely manner
- Ensure SPL gains as a result of instruction in accordance with WIOA standards and ESOL Performance Standards (<http://www.doe.mass.edu/acls/frameworks/esol.pdf>)

Description of Administration:

- Keep attendance records
- Document lesson plans in provided format
- Attend monthly staff meetings
- Assist with intake evaluations and assessments
- Participate in staff workshops
- Complete 12+ additional professional development hours (required for DESE positions)

Qualities Needed for Position:

- BA or Master's degree in ESOL, Education or related field + more than 1 years of experience teaching adults
- Familiarity with DESE ESOL Frameworks curriculum and Career Ready 101 helpful
- Familiarity with learner-centered, goal-oriented participatory ESOL
- Sensitive to socio-economic and ethnic minority issues
- Strong communication, inter-personal skills, and classroom management skills
- Able to work independently and as part of a team
- Computer proficiency (i.e. Microsoft Office, Navigating Internet including ESL websites)
- BEST Plus and TABE testing certification preferred
- Bilingual a plus

The classes are funded by the Department of Elementary and Secondary Education (DESE). The classes are for adults.
